as I like to do at the beginning of a new year, I do a little number sketch about the significance of the resultant number or root number for the year, in this case 2-0-2-3.

We've seen the result (in hindsight) of what transpired for 2022, a 6 year. If your year wasn't up to par, perhaps it had to do with problematic relationships within the family, the larger family of acquaintences, associates, and/or resources. Or a sense of imbalance. Or a sense of being deprived. These seem to be particularly relevant to the number 6.

So, as we think ahead about the number 7, think about greater harmonies possible through contemplation of one of the special numbers of perfection. A combination of 3+4: trinity plus stability or rootedness. Setting these numbers as objects together, with 4 on the bottom and 3 on the top we get a basic pyramidal structure.

Find your personal year: If your birth year is ...


1, your personal year in 2023 is an 8: *Cash in, perfect your performance.*

s the clock chimes 2023, we welcome a new year with an astrological emphasis on the power of the individual. Restart self-assertion. This year the adage, 'be the change you want to be in the world' has never been clearer. 2023 is the year of personal authenticity. The planetary shifts trigger a way to personal authenticity through resource management and self-esteem, healing the inner child, and a commitment to one's spiritual path. 5 Science-Backed Wound Healers Found in Nature

he natural biological process that occurs in your body to heal a wound is as incredible as it is complex. Four precise phases – hemostasis, inflammation, proliferation and remodeling – must occur in the proper sequence and with the correct timing for the wound to heal successfully. [But so] many factors may interfere with this process that impaired wound healing is common place.

During hemostasis, blood vessels are constricted and platelets aggregated to stop bleeding. The inflammatory stage follows, which includes an influx of inflammatory cells that release mediators and cytokines to trigger the formation of new blood vessels (angiogenesis), blood clotting and reepithelialization (formation of new epithelium), which continues into the proliferative phase. [The proliferative phase] can last for several weeks and includes the formation of granulation tissue, a key part of wound healing. The last phase, remodeling, begins about three weeks after the initial wound and may last up to one year while the wound fully heals – assuming the process works as it should.

What interferes with wound healing? Age, stress, smoking, nutrition, alcohol intake, medications and health conditions like diabetes and obesity may interfere with the wound healing process. It's estimated that nearly 2.5% of the US population have chronic wounds that won't heal. [Other underlying health conditions like high blood pressure and kidney disease are also] associated with chronic nonhealing wounds; in these cases, addressing the health issue will help to resolve the wound

[Meanwhile], there are many natural compounds that also lend support to wound healing, some of which you may have in your home right now.

Nature's Top Wound Healers

1. Honey ... is a broad-spectrum antibacterial agent, lowers prostaglandin* levels while elevating nitric oxide end products, processes that help explain honey's woundhealing powers. [*Prostagladins are hormone-like substances derived from various fatty acids that regulate blood pressure, muscle contraction.]

In a study of critically ill children with pressure injuries, those treated with Manuka honey were 1.9 times more likely to have their wound completely healed than those who received only standard care.

Those treated with honey also had a shorter time to complete healing – seven days for the honey group versus nine days for standard care – with no allergic reac-

he first time I learned about colloidal gold was in the spring of 1996, and an entertaining meeting with the manufacturer followed shortly thereafter.

2. Aloe Vera With anti-inflammatory, antiulcer, antibacterial and antifungal properties, aloe vera's role in wound healing is well
established. The aloe compound aloesin
affects the inflammation, proliferation and
remodeling wound healing phases and
accelerated wound closure rates in animal
studies. Aloe vera gel was also effective for
treating diabetic ulcers and ... cesarean
wound healing. When researchers tried a mixture of aloe vera gel and aloe vera flower, [there
were] significant synergistic wound healing effects.
Even taking aloe vera orally led to accelerated
wound healing compared to no treatment in a
study on rats.

3. Kiwi fruit ... has antibacterial pro-angiogenic (blood vessel forming) properties, along with proteolytic enzymes. In a pilot study of 37 people with neuropathic diabetic foot ulcers, treatment with kiwi extract twice daily for 21 days led to significantly higher amounts of collagen and granulation tissues compared to the control group.

Actinidin a protein-dissolving enzyme in kiwi was also found to improve "different aspects of the wound healing process." Similar benefits of kiwi extract were found [to aid people] with bedsores, while kiwi wound dressings for 10 days also led to better healing than normal saline irrigation for cutaneous wounds.

4. Curcumin ... is an active compound in the spice turmeric, reduces inflammation, protects against oxidative stress and modulates phase II detoxification enzymes. It's

believed that curcumin has skin regeneration and wound healing potential... compared to the control group in an animal study. Turmeric gel extract [has been shown to lead] to faster wound healing when applied topically. ...

5. L-Arginine* ... also known as simply arginine, is an amino acid that your body uses to help produce proteins. In your body, arginine is converted to nitric oxide, which helps widen blood vessels, [with arginine supplementation leading to improved blood flow to the limbs in humans as well as stimulating the release of growth hormone and insulin-like growth factor], which promote wound healing. [*High L-Arginine foods are meat, fish poultry, dairy, nuts, spirulina and quite a few veggies and fruits.]

In addition to supporting healing of cutaneous [skin] wounds, arginine may also improve the healing of fractures and impaired wounds caused by diabetes or those due to hemorrhage and trauma. One study also revealed that the wound-healing benefits of arginine may be further boosted by simultaneous consumption of omega-3 fats.

Beyond dietary and supplement measures, support wound healing by engaging in healthy activities like exercise, getting quality sleep each night and reducing stress**. Engaging in mindfulness programs may be beneficial for wound healing, showing that you can best promote your body's healing potential via methods that support your overall physical and mental health. [** St. John's Wort should also prove helpful in stress relief.]

n the evening of Thursday, Dec. 8, 2022, OneWeb launched 40 satellites from Cape Canaveral, Fla., bringing the total number of active satellites in orbit around the Earth to more than 7,000. Even the first fleet of 28 military satellites launched by the US caused a worldwide pandemic of influenza* when they became operational on June 13, 1968. The Hong Kong flu began in June 1968,* lasted through April 1970, and killed up to four million people worldwide.

AST SpaceMobile On Sep. 10, 2022, AST SpaceMobile launched the largest, and probably the most powerful, commercial communications array ever put into space. It is the first of a planned fleet of 243 Bluebird satellites designed to connect directly with people's existing mobile phones*, no matter where on Earth they may be located. The size of its solar array - 64 square meters - is causing alarm among astronomers because it is as bright as the brightest stars during the hours after sunset and before sunrise.

So far, AST SpaceMobile is working with RakutenMobile, AT&T, Bell Canada, Telecom Argentina, Africell, Liberty Latin America and Orange, for a potential customer base of 1.8 billion mobile phone subscribers. [Ed's: Another 1.8 billion numbskulls.]

The immensely powerful signals from the Bluebird satellites are also worrying radio astronomers... The effective radiated power of each satellite, according to AST's filings with the FCC, will be up to 83 million watts, and the exposure level at the surface of the earth from such beams, according to my calculations, will be up to 3 nanowatts per square centimeter, which is 100 times more radiation than what I am exposed to in my house in Santa Fe from the nearest cell towers.

Space debris expert: Orbits will be lost - and people will die ... Up until about a decade ago, an average of 80 to 100 satellites per year were launched into varying orbits. Some reentered Earth's atmosphere quickly, while others will remain in orbit for decades. ... In the last five years, driven largely by the rise of communications networks such as SpaceX's Starlink [Elon Musk's baby] and a proliferation of small satellites, the number of objects launched into space has increased dramatically.

...with more broadband networks like Amazon's Project Kuiper on the way.

This radically increasing number of satellites, most of which are **orbiting within 1,000 km of the Earth's surface***, comes as low-Earth orbit is more cluttered with debris than ever.

*Editor's note: Which makes them very vulnerable to solar storms capable of knocking lots of these things out of their low-Earth orbits, where they will fall like bombs.







dgar Cayce mentioned Lemuria in 45 readings, but when he was asked for details he usually replied: "If you want to learn about Mu or Lemuria consult Churchward."

Col. James Churchward (1851-1936) was a British engineer who had studied at Oxford. As a soldier he was stationed in India where he became close friends with an elderly monk from a nearby temple. Eventually, Churchward and the monk worked on deciphering sacred documents that had been carefully hidden for thousands of years in secret archives in a nearby temple. They were written in an ancient script called Nacaal which the elderly monk was able to decipher. The fragile documents described an ancient seafaring civilization in the Pacific Ocean. Churchward referred to the extensive civilization as the Motherland of Mu. He was so intrigued by what he read that he determined to learn more. The monk said other tablets about Mu were in Burma,

Churchward spent most of the rest of his life researching and traveling; searching ... monasteries in eastern Asia, on Pacific Islands, Central America, and in the southeastern US. When Churchward needed money to finance his research and travels, he came to [the US] and, using his engineering skills, invented [NCV]* steel which was an extremely hard almost impenetrable alloy. He sold it to the US government who used it for helmets [and for other armor-plating purposes] during World War 1. The \$1/4 million he earned enabled him to continue his research and travel and eventually write five books: "The Lost Continent of Mu," "Sacred Symbols of Mu," "Cosmic Sources as They Were Taught in Mu," "The Children of Mu," "Second Book of the Cosmic

[Churchward's work offers confirmations of what Cayce said about Lemuria in his readings. He compiled and compared information from many hundreds of sources – inscriptions, ancient writings, legends etc. – from all around the world].

Editor's comment: Legendary vanished continents like Mu/Lemuria are frequently discounted by academe who prefer the version of prehistory compressed into the Judeo-Christian narrative, i.e., biblically "pure," or, "If it ain't in the Bible, it ain't so." 

▼ lusters composed of a few atoms tend to be spherical. They are usually organized in "shells" [quotes added of atoms around a central atom. This is the case for many elements, but not for gold!

Experiments and advanced computations have shown that freestanding clusters of twenty gold atoms take on a pyramidal shape. They have a triangular ground plane made up of ten neatly arranged atoms, with additional triangles of six and three atoms, topped by a single atom [see figure on right].



The remarkable tetrahedral structure has now been imaged for the first time with a scanning tunneling microscope. This high-tech microscope can visualize single atoms. It operates at extremely low temperatures (-269° below zero) and uses quantum tunneling of an electrical current from a sharp scanning metallic tip through the cluster and into the support. Quantum tunneling is a process where electrical current flows between two conductors without any physical contact between them. The researchers used intense plasmas in a complex vacuum chamber setup to sputter gold atoms from a macroscopic piece of gold.

Zhe Li, the main author of the paper, currently at the Harbin Inst. of Technology, Shenzhen:

Part of the sputtered atoms grow together to small particles of a few up to a few tens of atoms, due to a process comparable with condensation of water molecules to droplets... We selected a beam of clusters consisting of exactly twenty gold atoms. We landed these species with one of the triangular* facets onto a substrate covered with a very thin layer of kitchen salt (NaCl), precisely three atom layers thick.

Editor's comment: Hmmm. Perhaps the selection of the tri-angular structure itself, and the 3 atom layers thick "informed" the gold atoms to array themselves in a 3infused pyramidal structure - the 4th side being the base area. What do you think? ◊

The study also revealed the peculiar electronic structure of the small gold pyramid. Similar to noble gas atoms or aromatic molecules, the cluster only has completely filled electron orbitals,* which makes them much less reactive than clus-

ters with one or a few atoms more or less.

Gold clusters ranging from a few to several dozens of atoms in size are known to possess remarkable properties. [Eds: More on these properties later.]

The new discovery helps scientists evaluate the catalytic and optical performances of these clusters, which is relevant for designing cluster-based catalysts and optical devices. Recent applications of clusters include utilization in fuel cells and carbon capture.

Many of the Woolly Bear caterpillars we have seen this fall have dense hair. This is an indication the winter will be cold.


Conclusion So, does the coloring of the woolly bear caterpillar change due to their diet or the upcoming winter? *I guess we will have to wait to find out.* ■

he number 13 often appears in nature, especially in relation to animals. For example, turtles have 13 plates a sure indication of the 13 moons during a Sun-Moon cycle. Here's an old astronomer's trick to find out. To make the color of a star really pop, tap your telescope. The resulting smear of light will look extra colorful [because there's more of the color to see].

Editor's comment: This technique reminds me of an artist putting a big gob of paint on his pallet and "smearing" it out to get a better idea of the strength of a given color.

Amateur astronomer Paolo Palma* of Naples, Italy, tried this for 14 bright stars [see above graphic]: "Here is a mosaic of the colors of the brightest stars visible from Italy," says Palma. "I took them dur-

ing this year by deliberately shocking the telescope. As the Italian poet Filippo Zamboni said, in this way the colors of the stars seem to come out of nowhere!" Turns out it's an old poet's trick, too.

"The photographic parameters are the same for all shots and they have not undergone any extra processing to enhance their colors," he adds.

Stars have different colors because they are different temperatures. The hottest stars are blue, with temperatures around 25,000 K. Red is the color of the coldest stars, which have surface temperatures of approximately 3,000 K. Palma captured almost the entire range.



ast Indian author, mystic and founder of the Self-Realization Fellowship. World traveled and a world teacher, **Paramhansa Yogananda** carried Eastern philosophy to the West.

He was born **Mukunda Lal Ghosh** to a devout and well-to-do Bengali family. During childhood, Yogananda had vivid memories of being a yogi during previous lifetimes in the Himalayas. A spiritually precocious child, he was encouraged toward the religious calling by his mother, and he met many holy men and yogis who aided him along his path.

In 1910, at age 17, he met the revered Swami Sri Yukteswar Giri, whom he had often seen during his meditations, and the recognition, joy, and empathy between Master and disciple was immediate and joyful. He completed his studies at Calcutta University while being taught spiritual discipline by his guru for close to a decade, in the Indian tradition. In 1915, he took formal vows as a monk of India's venerable monastic Swami Order, at which time he received the name Yogananda.

A natural born teacher, in 1917, he founded a "how-to-live" school for boys, where modern educational methods were combined with yoga training and instruction in spiritual ideals. His curriculum was always more concerned with developing the whole individual rather than only the intellect. He joked that having renounced the life of a family man, he ended up with even more children than he might have fathered.

In 1920, he was invited to serve as India's delegate to an international congress of religious leaders convening in Boston. His address to the congress, on "The Science of Religion," was enthusiastically received. When Yogananda arrived in America on Sep. 20, 1920, the "New World" was ready to receive the advanced teachings that had previously been reserved for monastics and chelas* in ashrams. Science, literacy, communication, and new spiritual insights had just begun breaking down the dark ages of theology and dogma. He founded his fellowship to disseminate worldwide his teachings on India's ancient science and philosophy of Yoga and its time-honored tradition of meditation, introducing the Bhagavad Gita and other scriptures to help raise the consciousness of humanity.

[*From yogapedia.com: Chela is the Sanskrit term for a person who follows a guru and means "one who is eager to learn" ... synonymous with disciple ... includes a relationship with the guru, which is especially sacred and significant. [Eds: There are parallels within Catholicism and other versions of Christianity.]

Yogananda lectured and taught on the East coast of American for several years and in 1924 began a speaking tour across the country. [He spoke of the underlying unity of the world's great religions in his lectures which were attended by thousands drawn to his message.] ...

Yogananda's articulate and sincere introduction to the disciplines of the East opened the door for many other Indian teachers and gurus, as a serious interest in yoga and meditation made great inroads in the West. His main mission was to build a lasting bridge of World Brotherhood based on raising the spiritual awareness between the East and West.

In 1925, he established an international headquarters for Self-Realization Fellowship in Los Angeles. His writing began to increase in the '30s, including a series of lessons for home study. In 1935, Yogananda toured Europe for six months and India for a year, meeting Mahatma Gandhi and other renowned spiritual figures. At this time his own guru, Swami Sri Yukteswar, bestowed on him India's highest spiritual title, Paramahansa (supreme swan). . . .

His life story, "Autobiography of a Yogi," 1946, [is] a perennial bestseller ... in continuous publication since it first appeared and has been translated into 18 languages. It is widely regarded as a modern spiritual classic.

"Millions of people never analyze themselves. Mentally they are mechanical products of the factory of their environment, preoccupied with breakfast, lunch, and dinner, working and sleeping, and going here and there to be entertained. They don't know what or why they are seeking, nor why they never realize complete happiness and lasting satisfaction. By evading selfanalysis, people go on being robots, conditioned by their environment. True self-analysis is the greatest art of progress."

"Don't depend on death to liberate you from your imperfections. ... Whatever you have made of yourself thus far, so will you be hereafter. And when you reincarnate, you will bring that same nature with you. To change, you have to make the effort. This world is the place to do it."

Trans-Neptune and Other Point Symbols (See symbols on pg 15)

Other symbols appear in the charts above, e.g., the *Centaur group* between Jupiter and Neptune, presumed to have originated in the Kuiper Belt. Major ones are *Pholus, Nessus, Chariklo*. Some "plutoids" are often used in chart analysis, with orbital periods so long, that unless they contact an angle or natal planet, their impact is likely to be mainly unconscious – or perhaps, "pre-conscious," e.g., *Eris, Makemake, Haumea. Try to match the symbols with their names. Points* include the *Vertex* (like a "V" with an "x" at the bottom); *Earth*, a circle with an upright cross; *Part of Fortune*, a "X" in a circle, and the *Black Moon Lilith*, reverse black crescent above a cross, associated with unbounded emotion (the nature of which will depend upon the sign it appears in). Information on the Centaurs, so named, stem from the first of them discovered in 1977, subsequently named Chiron. *The Greek tale of* what happened between Heracles and the Centaurs *gives many insights to taboo / unleashed impulses and areas of emotional wounding arising from them along with their collection of consequences*. Be that as it may, the group of asteroids between Saturn-Neptune has proven to be a fruitful area for Archetypal astrology, from Chiron on out.

Centaur Primer

The material on some of the outer bodies, and several named Centaurs below is from TimePassages, and most glyphs.

Chariklo ... was a sea nymph and Chiron's wife and mother of Tiresias, the blind seer. Astronomically, the orbital period for Chariklo is around 62 years. Her orbit ranges between Saturn and Uranus but doesn't intersect Saturn's orbit (unlike that of Chiron). The astrological archetype of Chariklo seems to represent individuals who are able to see the unknown more readily. She is prominent in the charts of inventors and science fiction authors. She represents turning toward the mystical and forging an opening to the numinous unknown. Where Chariklo is found in the natal chart may represent a place of wisdom that transcends the

Makemake ... the second "new" [quotes added] planet, or dwarf planet, or 'plutoid', to be officially named...

The period of MakeMake is 310 years The official name refers to the creation god of Easter Island, or Rapa

Nui. In size somewhat smaller than either Pluto or Eris... [Makemake] is the creation god of Rapa Nui,

MakeMake symbolizes a connection with environmental [lessons learned the hard way]. Where he is found in charts there can be found also the wisdom of the earth and the capacity for spiritual renewal.

boundaries of the natural world, a place where you must 'close your eyes to see

Haumea... The third trans-Neptunian Object, or TNO, to be officially designated as a dwarf planet, after Eris and MakeMake, Haumea was discovered just after Christmas 2004 (discoverer Mike Brown). Its discovery was officially announced on July 29th, 2005, by his group. Haumea is different from other TNOs in that it is rocky, as befits a goddess of the earth, and rotating extremely rapidly – a revolution every 4 hours. As a result, its shape is elongated, like a small cigar [or an elongated egg]. Its orbital period is 283 years. Creation goddess of the islands of Hawaii, Haumea was the source of many gods and goddesses as well as of the race of humankind. Pele, Hi'iaka, Namaka, Laka and many others... Her skill at childbirth is recounted in countless stories. Children sprang from different parts of her body...

Chiron (Has something over a 50-year orbit; NASA's site: 50.39 years. The ".39" years is approximately 4 months) I've included quite a bit about Chiron in previous Pathfinders, so will simply say that although characterized by the astrological community as "the wounded healer," often missed is the character of the wound Chiron received: he was an immortal, being a sun of Zeus, so when he was hit by one of Heracles' poisoned arrows he didn't die, but his wound never healed. (He received a poison arrow shot when Heracles tried to put down that drunken Centaur bacchanal.) His energy shows up in an area of life that won't be healed, but must just be tolerated, and where we surrender to the fact of our being wounded.

Eris (Goddess of Strife and Discord) This Goddess planetoid, about the size of Pluto, has roughly twice Pluto's orbital period (557 years to about 250 years for Pluto). Her energy is to upend established relationships, tradition and "the way things were." One way to deal with Her energy is to acknowledge the disruption and find ways to work with it or around it — taking advantage of chaotic circumstances to seek a better order. Eris definitely doesn't want to be left out of things — like that evil fairy who wasn't invited to Sleeping Beauty's christening and so cursed the beautiful child. We are called upon to undo that curse with appropriate work-arounds (like the other 11 fairies at Sleeping Beauty's christening).

Lilith*... Black Moon Lilith represents the apogee of the lunar orbit, where it lies farthest from the earth. This mystical astrological point cycles once around the chart every nine years... [Although there is an asteroid with the same name as well as an unverified "second moon" of Earth] Black Moon Lilith has been the most typically used in modern Western Astrology. Lilith represents an important piece of the feminine that has been lost or shunned in modern patriarchal society. She was worshipped in ancient Babylonia as the handmaiden of Innana and also viewed with distrust as the archetype of wild and uncontrolled sexuality. She is identified in Hebrew mythology as the first and rejected wife of Adam, who found [independent].

Nessus has an orbital period of 122 1/2 years. Just as the orbit of Nessus links Saturn with Pluto. The mythology of Nessus partakes of some of the same elements as the other Centaur stories, including painful death. When Nessus was ferrying Hercules' bride, Deianeira, across a river, he tried to rape her and so Hercules shot him through the heart with a poisoned arrow... Nessus represents those poweful and instinctual urges, those "unredeemed" impulses that seek to satisfy their own appetites (and lusts) at the expense of any self-restraint.

Pholus was discovered on Jan. 9, 1992 and termed a Centaur, the second of a class of small objects with eccentric orbits beyond the path of Saturn. Pholus is red in color and has an orbital period of 92 years. The orbit of Pholus links Saturn and Neptune. Pholus suffered a fatal wounding from the poison arrows of Hercules, after a fracas in which the wine he was entrusted with was inadvertently opened to please Hercules. Pholus sacrificed himself for the greater good, a Neptunian theme... There is also the motif of intoxication, which might be expected from the link between Saturn [practical reality], and Neptune [numinous, out-of-thisworld experience.]



Martin Luther King, Jr. – bio

American clergyman and inspirational leader of the civil rights movement. A symbol of the struggle against black segregation in the American South, he won the Kennedy Peace Prize and the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964. Galvanizing black Americans into action through his electrifying oratory skills, he rose to become a legend and national hero in his own time.

Growing up in a pious, proud and progressive black community in segregated Atlanta, King was the son of Alberta and Martin Luther King, a Baptist minister at the Ebeneezer Baptist Church. Living in a family of black Brahmins he never experienced poverty, yet he continuously heard his father preach from his pulpit, "I don't care how long I have to live with this system. I will never accept it."

Early On... King's rhetorical ability showed early. A pastor's son of whom much was expected, he won an oratorical contest sponsored by the Black Elks* in 1944. [*A benevolent, non-profit fraternal association founded in 1868.] Programmed from his early youth to follow in his father's and grandfather's footsteps in the ministry, by his teens he was uncomfortable with the emotionalism of fundamental Baptist services and sought a more liberal perspective. Enrolling in Morehouse College

in Atlanta, he vacillated between choosing a career as a doctor or a lawyer...

With his spiritual perspective enhanced by the liberal theologians at Morehouse, he enrolled at Crozer Theological Seminary in Penn. where he was one of 11 blacks in a student population of 90. Manifesting his innate sense of leadership, he became student body president and class valedictorian. He was ordained a minister in his father's church in 1947. Upon applying to Boston Univ. for graduate work, his professors wrote "His work is of the highest grade" and "He will probably become a big, strong leader among his people."

In 1955 at age 26, [he rejected stepping into] his father's pulpit at Ebeneezer Baptist in Atlanta. King's first position was at the prestigious Dexter Baptist Church at Montgomery, Alabama. When seamstress [Rosa] Parks refused to move to the back of the bus on Dec. 1st of that same year, King began his sermon to a church full of agitated supporters of her cause, four days after her courageous act.

"You know my friends, there comes a time when people get tired of being trampled over by the iron feet of oppression."

Individual cheers gave way to a resounding din within the church walls and King walked into history that day as the delegated spokesman for the Montgomery Bus Boycott.

When the Montgomery buses finally began to operate on a non-segregated basis 381 days later, King formed the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, giving

When it comes to building a spiritual bridge between his native Hinduism and Christianity, there is an individual whose influence was far more enduring and profound, yet who usually falls under the radar of those covering the Christo-Hindu interface: Paramahansa Yogananda...

Christo-Hinduism... is a term I have coined to describe a body of spiritual teachings to build a bridge between East and West by elucidating the common ground between Hinduism and Christianity. ... Christo-Hinduism resulted when the flow of religious teachings went from East to West. One of the best-known examples of Christo-Hindu teachings was when Sri Ramakrishna, undertook [to examine] Christianity and Jesus Christ from his Hindu perspective. ...

The spiritual keys to this interface or affinity lie in the doctrines or concepts of Monism, in which all lesser deities with name and form are particularized manifestations of a single, transcendent God of All, who is beyond all name and form...

The concept of a divine Incarnation

of God is called an Avatar, or "One Who Descends" in Hindu terminology. In an attempt to forge common ground between his native Hinduism and Christianity, Yogananda called his own line of gurus "Yogi-Christs of modern India." ...

In Christianity, the Monistic idea is expressed mainly in terms of the Holy Trinity, or its triune conception of the Godhead, in which a single, transcendent Supreme Being manifests in three different persons: God the Father, or God Transcendent; God the Son, or God Immanent; and God the Holy Spirit, or God in Action. [In Hinduism's Trinity, we have Brahma the Creator, Vishnu the Preserver, and Shiva the Destroyer or Transformer. Hinduism then branches out into myriad gods and goddesses – all various aspects of the One Divine Beingness].

She gave it to Yogananda for his safe keeping, and on the day that the amulet finally disappeared – that was the day that Yogananda magically met his guru, Sri Yukteswar.

him a sound base from which to operate his vast congregation of everyday soldiers for civil rights. His philosophy of passive resistance* led to his frequent arrests and tours through the Bible Belt, where he became known as "Alabama's Modern Moses." ... His greatest coup was the March on Washington on Aug. 28, 1963, where 200,000 people gathered to demand their civil rights and hear King make his famous speech, "I have a dream..." For [his views] he was stoned, physically attacked and his house was bombed. ...[*Eds: Demonstrated earlier in the century by Mahatma Gandhi, and his famous "Salt March."]

As society grew more militant in the mid-60's, King's interests widened to the Viet Nam War and those living in poverty. His plans for a Poor People's March on Washington in 1968 were interrupted by a sanitation workers' strike in Memphis, Tenn. On the evening of April 3, 1968, King delivered his legendary speech to supporters at the Mason Street Temple: "I have been to the mountaintop... I see the Promised Land. I may not get there with you, but mine eyes have seen the glory."*

The following evening, while standing on the balcony of the Lorraine Motel

in Memphis, he was shot to death at 6:01 pm EST by allegedly lone assassin James Earl Ray. King married Coretta Scott in 1957. They had four children, Yolanda Denise, Martin Luther King III, Dexter and Bernice Albertine.

*Editor's note: This was a chillingly stirring speech. Hearing it, you knew that he knew something terrible was about to happen. **Apr. 3, 1968** was just a few years shy of 100 years after the Civil War* (Apr. 9, 1865, to Apr. 15, 1861) hateful bigotry still boiled. Or was this more of the Cabal's work to "keep fear and loathing alive"? Perhaps. — A mind-blowing **750,000 people died in the** American Civil War, with about an equal number of wounded. 


